Ownership between the Charter Township of Canton and Priority Waste, LLC and authorize the Township Supervisor to execute any documents necessary to effectuate the limited consent, subject to final review and approval by the Township Attorney. Motion carried unanimously.

5) Request Approval to Renewal Microsoft Windows Server Licensing (ITI)

Motion by Siegrist, supported by Slavens to approve the creation of a purchase order not to exceed \$23,508.60, payable to Dell Marketing, for the renewal of Microsoft Licensing Agreement covering a period of one (1) year. Motion carried unanimously.

6) Request Approval to Renew BS&A SaaS Annual Services Agreement (ITI)

Motion by Siegrist, supported by Borninski to approve the creation of a purchase order in an amount not to exceed \$248,636 payable to BS&A Software for the renewal of the Township's SaaS annual services agreement and online permit service fees for the period of April 1, 2026 through March 31, 2027. Motion carried unanimously.

7) Consider the approval of a Parks Equipment Operator position and Letter of Agreement between Canton Township and the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees (AFSCME) Union (HR)

Motion by Siegrist, supported by Slavens to approve the addition of a Parks Equipment Operator position to the Parks, Recreation and Community Services Department and the associated LOA between Canton Township and AFSCME. Motion carried unanimously.

8) Consider Authorizing a Purchase Order to Fishbeck for Construction Engineering Services for the Sidewalk Gap Project (MSD)

Motion by Siegrist, supported by Borninski to issue a Purchase Order to Fishbeck for the not to exceed amount of \$19,956 and reduce the existing Purchase Order issued to Land Matters Inc. for sidewalk easement acquisition by the same amount of \$19,956 for the 2026 Sidewalk Gap project. Motion carried unanimously.

9) Consider First Reading of an Amendment to Appendix A – Zoning of the Code of Ordinances for AMM Canton, LLC Rezoning (MSD)

Motion by Siegrist, supported by Slavens to introduce and hold the first reading of Planning Application # PZ26-00096, which rezones parcel no. 047-99-0005-001 at 41190 Ford Rd. from C-4, Interchange Service district to C-3, Regional Commercial district, with no changes to the CBD Overlay zoning, as the proposal meets the standards of Section 27.06(D)(4) of the Zoning Ordinance as stated in the Planning Commission's motion. Motion carried unanimously.

10) Consider Site Plan Modification for Canton-Western Wayne Building Renovation (MSD)

Motion by Siegrist, supported by Ganguly to approve Resolution 2026-36 to Approve the Canton-Western Wayne Building Renovation Site Plan Modification, Planning Application #133-SPX-8759. Motion carried unanimously.

11) Consider Camp Mirage at Friendship Church Special Land Use Modification (MSD)

Motion by Siegrist, supported by Ansari to approve Resolution 2026-37 to amend condition #1 of Resolution 2026-9 for Camp Mirage in Planning Application #PZ25-00006.
