Motion by Siegrist, supported by Slavens to approve resolution #2026-43 for signature by the Township Clerk and authorize a purchase order to Wayne County when the final cost is known in an amount not to exceed \$27,000. Motion carried unanimously.

- 4) Consider First Reading of an Amendment to Appendix A – Zoning of the Code of Ordinances for Chlebek Rezoning (MSD)

Motion by Siegrist, supported by Slavens to introduce and hold the first reading of Planning Application # PZ26-00108, which rezones parcel no. 127-99-0001-000 at 4843 Denton Road from R-1, Single-Family Residential to R-3, Single-Family Residential, as the proposal meets the standards of Section 27.06(D)(4) of the Zoning Ordinance as stated in the Planning Commission's motion. Motion carried unanimously.

- 5) Consider Canton Center Condominium Preliminary Site Plan (MSD)
